Would you, or would you know, of anyone who could spare a little bit of time to audit our PTFA accounts? It would be best suited to someone with financial knowledge or who has handled any kind of accounts. Please get in touch with the PTFA if you can help, we would really appreciate it.

Match Funding Explained

What is it?

If the PTFA hold an event, for example, the Summer Fair, and it makes £1,000, it can try and find a company that will match that same amount, or provide a partial amount, like it's a 'reward' for raising the money.

With the PTFA being a registered charity, we can apply to any company that provides a match funding opportunity.

When can we apply?

It is retrospective, so you can only apply for match funding once you have hosted your event and know the amount that you have raised.

Who do we apply to?

Big companies, such as banks and insurance companies, are the main companies who may offer the match funding service. However, with the economy not so booming at the minute, many companies have stopped offering match funding opportunities.

How do we apply?

The only thing it involves is filling out a form and then waiting. You also have more of a chance of receiving match funding if the person filling out the form is an employee of the company being applied to. It demonstrates a direct relationship with the school, and hence the PTFA.

So, do you know if your company offers match funding opportunities?

The PTFA would love to hear from you if they do, especially since we have a few of our larger fundraising events coming up.

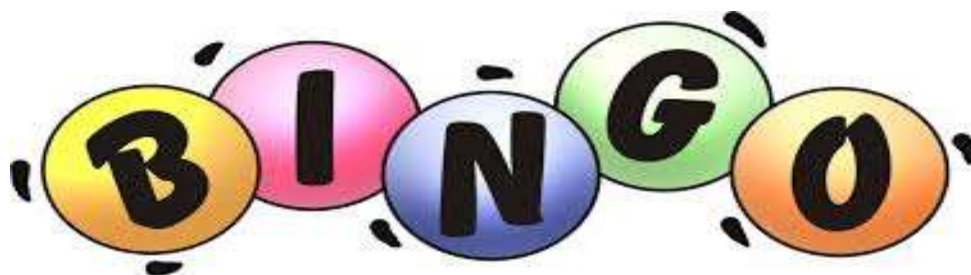
Match funding is an excellent way of making some more money with not too much more effort after the big event!
