HOLIDAYS IN TERM TIME

We added this information to the Longsands Link back in September for our new parents, but we have added it again as a general reminder of the process for term time leave requests. We are unable to authorise leave within school term time unless the reason for the requested absence is for an exceptional circumstance. A term time leave request form should be completed and submitted to the school office as soon as you know that there is a possibility that your child will be wanting to take time out of school during term time. If the absence isn't authorised, it will be recorded as <u>unauthorised</u> term time leave.

If the amount of days taken hits the threshold for a penalty notice from the Local Education Authority, these penalty notices are currently £120 per parent, per child. If these penalties are paid within 21 days of issue, then the charges will reduce to £60 per parent, per child. The threshold is currently **five** full school days, which equates to ten school day sessions.

Term time leave request forms are available at the school office, or by contacting Mrs Wilds directly, and are available in the document holders in the main entrance area. Our school attendance policy with details of term time leave can be viewed on the school website or by

clicking here. Any term time leave requests we receive at school which are for Monday 15th April onwards, will be kept for Mrs Lang to make a decision on when she starts her new post as Headteacher after the Easter holidays.
