GIFTS & HOSPITALITY

In keeping with Lancashire County Council Internal Financial Regulations, we need to draw the information below to the attention of parents and carers should anyone be considering a gift to a member of school staff. *Prior approval should be sought, where possible from the Headteacher before school staff accept any gift or hospitality that is estimated to be beyond a face value of £25. Gifts should not be in the form of cash or securities; the gift or hospitality is a oneoff and not repeated on a regular basis; and the gift or hospitality is given openly, not secretly.*

Any offer or receipt of gifts or hospitality with a token value of above £25 shall be declared and the Headteacher should maintain a register of all declarations of gifts and hospitality. Completed declaration forms should be completed within 10 days of the date of the gift or hospitality. The register will be open to inspection by the Chair of Governors and / or LCC Senior Officer (including LCC Audit) as appropriate and reported to the Governing Body and recorded in the Minutes of the Meeting.
