

Summer Camps at Longridge Cricket Club

We are pleased to announce that we shall, again, be hosting Summer Camps during the summer holidays.

W/C 5th August: Tom Howarth, Longridge 1st XI All rounder, will be running a multi-sports camp during w/c 5th August aimed at 8-11 year olds. Mon-Fri 08.30 – 5.30pm with a range of sports and team challenges available: cricket, tri-golf, rounders, dodgeball, athletics etc. The cost for this camp will be £20 per day with breakfast and an afternoon snack provided or £15 for half a day. Or book for the full week for £80. Tom has considerable experience in running summer camps and will be assisted by Zac Christie, LCC 1st XI Batsman and Level 2 coach.

W/C 12th & 19th August: Shaun Cockell, our 4th Team Captain, will be running cricket camps during w/c 12th and w/c 19th August from 9am to 3pm every day (Mon-Fri) with an hour break for lunch. These are aimed at anyone in the 5 to 11 years old age range and at all abilities. The cost is £20 per day. The days will contain mixed skills activities, games and cricket challenges. This camp will be run by resident senior Shaun Cockell who moved to the area from Yorkshire, two years ago and chose to make Longridge his home club. He has run cricket summer camps for several years in Yorkshire and here for the last two years. *Early drop offs and later pickups can also be accommodated by prior arrangement*.

All activities will be run outside but alternative activities will be planned for inclement weather. All you need is a packed lunch with drink, sun hat and sun screen for those sunny days (bring your cricket gear if you have it).
