Mr Mason – collection and delivery of bags of soil donated by B&Q Community Re-use Scheme (classes have been able to plant many different seeds for the outdoor garden)


Mrs Woods & Mrs Riley – Easter egg donations

Monies raised

Below is a summary of our events and how much we raised at each:



In total, we have raised $\pounds4,802.43$ this year - a fantastic amount!



So, where is this money going?

£1172 is from the silver change tube challenge. This money will not go into PTFA funds for anything we wish to purchase because each class has kept their raised amount to spend on what they chose as a class. Thanks to your previous donations, we were able to purchase the tubes and coordinate the project. To recap on what the classes wanted:

Reception – role play resources

- Y1 resources for the little outdoor area
- Y2 books; 3 x Twits, 2x Magic Finger, 4x Fantastic Mr fox, The Pelly & Me, 4x James and the Giant Peach
- Y3 class book sets of The Twits and Stig of the Dump and new headphones for iPads
- Y4 headphones for listening station
- Y5 headphones and audio books for listening station
- Y6 a mini laptop

In the Link on Friday 28th June, Mrs Calvert gave us pictures of her transformed outdoor area.

The teachers are in the process of purchasing the items for the class. Any money that hasn't been spent yet in each class will move up with them next term, so that they continue to reap the benefit of what they saved for the challenge.

This leaves £3,630.43. The majority of this money will go towards new benches for the KS2 playground (see example in the picture below). They will be used for seating at playtimes and for outside class time.

DIRECT REQUEST FOR YOUR TIME

Unfortunately, we have not seen any increase to the education budget so schools continue to need outside resources to help them boost funds. If the PTFA can keep raising money for the extras, this gives every child the possibility to have the best experiences possible at school.

The PTFA is enthusiastic to run fun and worthwhile events to let everyone participate and raise as much money as we can for reinvestment. There are many ideas and things we could do: a Christmas craft afternoon, a Christmas games afternoon, discos, a ladies' night, a family bingo night, a race night, another tube challenge, a treasure hunt, a sausage sizzle . . . the list is endless!!

However, some of these things may not get organised because we don't have enough manpower or the commitment from enough people to help it all happen. Fundraising events may have to be scaled down and perhaps not even run in the future.

Everyone, parents/teachers/carers, etc, deserves to know about this situation. We are currently looking for a new treasurer and secretary. These roles are a mandatory requirement as part of the guidelines set by the Charity Commission, which every PTFA must follow.

There are only six parents who are due to continue on the PTFA in 2019/20. With every current member working and having other commitments, it will be very difficult to keep functioning on such a small team. It is a commitment to volunteer, but it is to help your child at their school. If the PTFA had to scale down their activities, the school would miss out on **£3k to £5k extra funding every year**.

The children would not be able to have the extras, for example:

- Digital education programmes like Times Table Rock Stars
- Christmas entertainment

DiscosSubsidy for trips/events

- Outdoor play equipment / furniture
- Additional supplies for classrooms

We have received queries on whether the PTFA could do more for the children. The simple answer is 'yes'. But we need your time to achieve more, either by coming on as a committee member, or by pledging your support to give us your time at one or two of our next events.

Art Project

The PTFA are hoping to fundraise by getting the children to make art work for items such as Christmas cards. We use a company that produce the products for us. Art work will be done by the children in school week commencing **7**th **October 2019**, then parents will be able to select from an array of products, such as cards, gift tags, and mugs. There will also be time for the children to do any extra art work at home that week.

As the cards are blank inside, the design can be anything so cards can be made for other occasions such as Eid or Easter.

Designs and forms will be collated in school on **Monday 14th October**, along with payment for what you would like to purchase. The company we are using also offers the chance to purchase online should you miss the date for submission into school. The only additional cost for this is the p&p to yourself. More details will follow.

The autumn disco will take place on **Friday 18th October 2019** in school. KS1 will have their disco first, with parents of Reception children being asked to attend the disco also. KS2 disco will follow. More information on times will be in the next newsletter.
