PRIMARY ADMISSION SEPTEMBER 2020

If you have a child who has their 4th birthday between 1st September 2019 and 31st August 2020, you must now apply for their place in Primary School. You still need to make an application even if they have a brother or sister at your chosen school. Applications should be made online to Lancashire County Council at **www.lancashire.gov.uk/schools** It is quick and easy to do and you will receive an email confirmation of your application. The deadline for all September 2020 applications is 11.59pm on **15th January 2020**

ADMISSION TO SECONDARY SCHOOL

If your child is in Year 6 it is now time to apply for their place in High School. You must still make an application even if they have a brother or sister at the chosen school. Applications should be made online to Lancashire County Council at **www.lancashire.gov.uk/schools** The deadline for all applications is 11.59pm on **31**st October 2019

ARE YOU ENTITLED

We want to make sure that we are providing your child with the best education and support

we can. Healthy school food has obvious health benefits and can help pupils establish healthy habits for life. Healthy school food can also help to improve pupils' readiness to learn. Families who receive certain benefits may be eligible for free school meals. Your child is eligible for free school meals if you're in receipt of one of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400.
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and
- Support Allowance
 Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190

Registering for free school meals could also raise an extra **£1,320** for your child's primary school to fund valuable support like extra tuition, additional teaching staff or after school activities. This additional money is available from central government for every child whose parent is receiving one of the benefits listed above. Please apply through your local authority on 01772 532109. (This is not the same as Universal Free School Meals which all children are entitled to in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to).

ATTENDANCE

Please remember that school starts at **8.55am** and this is the time that your child should be in their classroom for registration. Arriving late to school is disruptive to the rest of the class. If you are struggling with traffic, try setting off a little earlier, or packing bags and having everything ready for school the night before.
