NEW SCHOOL LUNCH MENU

ARRIVING LATE

Arriving late is disruptive to other children in class and to your child's progress.

As a school, money is added to the budget from LCC which can only be used for improving the school such as windows, doors etc. The money cannot be used to provide extra resources such as staffing etc. This year we have £6,000 added to our budget. Starting Music Tuition in School - "BMA Music- School Assembly"

Music

Following on from today's exciting school assembly we would like to offer the following musical lessons to your child. We currently offer **Piano/Singing** and **Guitar tuition**.

Our aim is to provide fun and enjoyable music lessons that help to develop your child's musical skills, confidence and overall appreciation of music. Lessons take place during school time and are either taught **in pairs** (20 mins) or on a **1 to 1 basis** (15 mins) with the children following a structured syllabus to ensure steady progress.

For new starters there will be a total of 6 lessons this term starting week commencing (w/c) 14/10/19 and ending w/c 02/12/19 (inclusive). This excludes lessons w/c 21/10/19 and w/c 28/10/19. Lessons then continue on a colling termly basis until you choose to stop (4 weeks' notice required please).

To register your child to start lessons with us simply:

- a) Complete the form at the bottom of this page (please fill in all boxes)
- b) Complete the attached Direct Debit payment form
- c) Make the initial manual payment (see below to cover lessons prior to the Direct Debit becoming active)
 (cheque or Bank Transfer (preferred) Account 65001826, Sort Code 016714)
- d) Return both completed forms (+ cheque if required) to the school office no later than Monday 4/10/19.

Our Direct Debit payment system is a proven simple way to pay for lessons. Existing parents love how easy it is and how costs are spread across the term rather than in one big termly payment. The first Direct Payment will be **start of November 2019** then continue on a monthly basis until you choose to stop. Lessons can either be in pairs (20 minutes) or 1 to 1 (15 minutes) as follows:

- <u>20 minutes in pairs</u> £5.00 per lesson (initial payment of £20 then Direct Debit payments of £13.75 per month November '19 to June '20 (inclusive) or until you give notice to stop)
- <u>15 minutes 1 to 1</u> £7.50 per lesson (initial payment of £30 then Direct Debit payments of £20.65 per month November '19 to June '20 (inclusive) or until you give notice to stop)

To finish lessons we simply ask for 4 weeks' notice where a final balancing payment will then be arranged. If for some reason you are unable to set up a Direct Debit please contact the office directly where an alternative arrangement may be possible.


