
HOW TO SIGN UP TO EASYFUNDRAISING (PC)

1. Go to www.easyfundraising.org.uk and search for

2. Choose to support this cause by clicking here



3. Register by creating your own account



4. Once you're registered you can start shopping!



5. There are hundreds of retailers to choose from.


Browse the retailers
