# **HOLIDAYS IN TERM TIME**

As we have new parents to school who may not be aware of the process, please could we remind everyone that leave within school term time will not be authorised by Mrs McKeown, unless the reason is for an exceptional circumstance. A term time leave form should be completed and submitted to school as soon as you know that there is a possibility that your child will be absent from school. If the absence isn't authorised, it will be recorded as unauthorised term time leave. If the amount of days taken hits the threshold for a penalty notice from the Local Education Authority, these are £120 per parent, per child. If these penalties are paid within 21 days of the issue date, the charges will reduce to

£60 per parent, per child.
