TIK TOK TREND REMINDER

We added details of this to Seesaw this week but here is a reminder to be aware of.

A TikTok trend, which involves using tiny magnets as fake tongue piercings has prompted the NHS to call for the metal balls to be banned amid a rise in people swallowing them. The viral prank sees people placing two magnetic balls on either side of their tongue and wiggling them around to create the illusion that the piercing is real. Ingesting more than one magnet can be life threatening and cause significant damage within hours, as

the balls are forced together in the intestines or bowels, squeezing the tissue so that the blood supply is cut off. At least 65 children have been admitted to hospital in England for urgent surgery in the last three years after swallowing magnets, leading the NHS to issue a patient safety alert earlier this month.
