Dear Parents / Carers

We are writing to you following our planned update to our PE Policy and would ask that you take time to read the following information regarding PE lessons. Our policy follows Lancashire County Council guidelines and is in place to keep your child safe. Please ensure that all of these points are being followed from January.

### Ear-rings

- All ear-rings should be removed for PE lessons.
- If your child cannot remove their own ear-rings we suggest that ear-rings are best left at home on PE days.
- Staff / other children are not allowed to remove or help to remove your child's ear-rings.
- The only exception to this is for the first 6 weeks after piercing. During this time ear-rings may be taped using
  ear-ring cover up tape (not plasters) This should be applied before your child comes to school, otherwise we will
  ask you to come into school during the day to do this.
- After the 6 week healing time, it will be expected that the ear-rings will be removed for PE.

#### PE kit

Children will continue to come to school in their PE kits on their PE days.

Exceptions to this will be in the Summer term for Reception and Year 6. You will be informed about this at the time.

### Our PE kit comprises:

- Royal blue shorts / plain navy blue jogging pants
- Lemon Longsands polo shirt
- Plain navy blue zip through hoodie
- Trainers with light coloured soles (Velcro fasteners for Reception /KS1)

Hoodies and jogging pants should be the correct colour with no logo or decoration.

### **Footwear**

For outdoor PE lessons children should wear trainers. For Gymnastics / Dance lessons children will be barefoot.

### Long hair

Long hair should always be tied back to prevent entanglement with equipment and to not obscure vision.

### Personal effects, including jewellery and cultural or religious adornments

- Personal effects, such as jewellery, religious artefacts, watches, hair slides, and sensory aids including glasses, should ideally always be removed to establish a safe working environment.
- Wristbands / watches monitoring physical activity may be worn in outdoor PE lessons if they are covered with a fabric sports wristband which should be provided by parents / carers.
- Wrist adornments worn for religious reasons may also be covered with a fabric sports wristband if they cannot be removed.

### Nails

Nails should be kept suitably short to avoid injury to self and others.

We thank you for your support in keeping everyone at school safe during PE lessons.
