EARRINGS – UPDATED PE POLICY

We have mentioned it a few times on recent newsletters and attachments, but just in case anyone missed it, please remember that if your child wears earrings they must either be removed or covered in micropore tape on PE days. Unfortunately staff are no longer able to do this due to LCC guidelines.

Earrings

- All earrings should be removed for PE lessons.
- If your child cannot remove their own earrings we suggest that earrings are best left at home on PE days.
- Staff / other children are not allowed to remove or help to remove your child's earrings.
- The only exception to this is for the first 6 weeks after piercing. During this time earrings may be taped using earring cover up tape (not plasters) This should be applied before your child comes to school, otherwise we will ask you to come into school during the day to do this.
- After the 6 week healing time, it will be expected that the earrings will be removed for PE.

Dear Parent/Carer.

This letter is to remind you that our school is participating in the Operation Encompass partnership scheme, between local schools, academies, colleges, community health agencies and Lancashire Police.

Operation Encompass was set up to provide early reporting to schools etc about any domestic abuse incidents that occur outside of school hours to which a young person attending Longsands has been exposed, and which might then have an impact on their schooling the following day. This information will be shared throughout the year, including school holidays and the weekends.

Information will only be shared with the school by the police where it is identified that a young person was present, witnessed or was involved in a domestic abuse incident.

A nominated member of school, known as the Encompass Key adult, will have access to this information on a secure and confidential email set up just for this purpose. The key adult at Longsands is myself as Designated Safeguarding Lead. I will be able to use the information passed on to ensure we are able to make provision for possible difficulties experienced by children or their families. The information is kept confidential and I will only share it on a needs to know basis, for instance to teaching staff of the child. It will not be shared with other children.

This initiative has been implemented across the whole of the Lancashire Police area. If you would like some information about it, you can view it online at www.operationencompass.org.

We are keen to offer the best support possible for our children and a recent review of Operation Encompass showed that is beneficial and supportive for all those involved.
